### Chief Roger Bissen:

Fire Fighter One class has been suspended for four weeks.

When responding to calls in the current situation – think about what you might be bringing home. Use common sense; think about the patients' health, your health, and your family.

EMS Calls:

Stay Outside until instructed by Medivac

Only EMT's as needed (unless there are not enough EMT's on scene)

Fire Calls:

Respond as normal

Keep staff at a minimum on the actual scene

The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has rules and guidelines for isolation – refrain from large groups (no more than 10 people)

The control barn burn on Saturday (March 21<sup>st</sup>) has been proposed until further notice.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Assistant Chief Tom Butler:

When coming back from a call, you need to decontaminate your gear/equipment; whether that's wiping your mask, or washing your gear. Remember think about the health of yourself and your family.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Assistant Chief Bruce Blum:

After calls make sure you are plugging in the trucks.

Watch your driving to a call –there was a citizen complaint regarding this.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Captain Chad Butler:

Can we get another plug-in for 33? There is no more plug-ins available – Chief Roger Bissen will work on it.
