

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE – February 11, 2015

Public Safety Committee met on Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at 11:30 A.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Meeting was called to order. Sharon Kroger made a motion, seconded by Dave Miller to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Chief Report:

- Gave an update on the City of Shelby Fire Department and they now have 26 members and for the next 6 months there will be mutual aid as they are in training. If there happens to be fire in the City of Tenant, Harlan will most likely assist.
- Tri-County discussion was brought up and this is our HAZ-MAT group which started in 2007. The Tri-Counties are Shelby which has 14 trained members, Harrison which has 5 trained members and Crawford which has 1 trained member. Each county pays in \$8,000 into a budget for their expenses and they have a 9 member board that meets monthly to review items. Roger told the Tri-County Board that he was going to talk to the City Council about having operations located at the Harlan Fire Department and after lengthy discussion the committee told Roger move forward and give us an update in 30 days.
- The Shelby County Racetrack Agreement draft was looked over and after a few changes and few questions, It was moved by Sharon Kroger and seconded by Dave miller to have Roger take this agreement to the City Attorney to have him review and have Roger come back with a final draft that the City Council can approve and then return to the Racetrack. Motion carried unanimously.

- Police Chief gave an update on how the new cameras are being utilized.
