Chairman Kroger called the meeting to order.

It was moved by Rudolph and seconded by Petersen to approve the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Petersen and seconded by Rudolph to approve the minutes of the 4/8/2021 Streets, Alleys & Sidewalks meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Exchange Street Streambank Preliminary Study Results were presented by Dave Sturm with Snyder & Associates. Drainage analysis, erosion control practices and streambank stabilization were discussed. A potential funding source included application with Hungry Canyons Alliance for grant up to 80%, with at least a 20% local match. The estimated total project cost is \$227,307.50.

Downtown Street Marking and corresponding map included with the meeting packet was discussed.
