

CITY OF HARLAN – HARLAN, IOWA – August 16, 2016

The City Council of the City of Harlan, Iowa met pursuant to law and the rules of said Council in regular session in the Council Chambers in City Hall at 5:15 o'clock P.M. the 16th day of August, 2016. The meeting was called to order by Gene Gettys, Mayor in the Chair, and the following Council members were:
